Taylor County Board of Commissioners
Regular Meeting
December 2, 2025

The Taylor County Board of Commissioners met in regular session at 6:00 p. m. on Tuesday, December 2, 2025, in the County Commissioners Meeting Room of the Taylor County Government Complex at 7 Ivy St., Butler, GA. Present were Chairman Tameka Harris, Commissioner Jeff Watson, Commissioner Dianne Renfroe, and Assistant County Manager Teresa Blackston.

Chairman Harris called the meeting to order at 6:00pm, Bo Crook gave the invocation. Commissioner Watson led the Pledge to the United States Flag and Commissioner Renfroe led the Pledge to the Georgia Flag.

Agenda approved on motion by Commissioner Renfroe, seconded by Commissioner Watson, and carried with all in favor.

The Minutes of the November 6, 2025, Regular Meeting were approved as distributed on motion by Commissioner Watson, seconded by Commissioner Renfroe and carried by voice vote with all in favor and none opposed.

Reports:

Planning and Zoning – Mr. John Hattaway brought before the Board, a beer and wine license for Scott Perry, owner of Golden Goose RV Park. Mr. Perry spoke to the Board regarding his request, he hosts several events at the RV park and wishes to be able to sell beer/wine. The events he hosts has live music and food trucks, so far he has hosted 2 events, his grand opening and an another live music event. Commissioner Watson made a motion to approve the beer and wine license for Scott Perry/Golden Goose RV Park, seconded by Commissioner Renfroe and carried with a voice vote of all in favor, none opposed.

Abb Preston, Taylor County EMS – Mr. Preston reported that during the month of November there were 169 calls, 96 transports to 9 hospitals.

Taylor County Fire Department – Mr. Keith Poole reported that the fire department responded to 19 calls in November. The Fire Department will be changing the way they accept donations, by opening a separate checking account so that it will not go through the budget. Commissioner Renfroe made a motion to approve the Fire department opening a separate checking account, seconded by Commissioner Watson, carried with a voice vote of all in favor, none opposed.

Project Manager – Mr. Crook reported to the Board that the Recreation building has the foundation laid and the parking lot graded, they are waiting on the concrete to be poured. Saunders Engineering provided the bids for LMIG, Scruggs (formerly Robinson Paving) won the bid at \$1,225,678.00. The Commissioners discussed the bond for the roads. Commissioner Renfroe made a motion to table the bond for the roads until a later time with more of the commissioners in attendance, seconded by Commissioner Watson, carried with a voice vote of all in favor, none opposed.

Chamber of Commerce: Ms. Nicole Acree shared some updates with the Board. The Chamber Banquet is scheduled for February 12, 2026, and December 6 will be the Taylor Made Market in conjunction with the Reynolds Christmas Celebration.

Development Authority – Ms. Acree shared that Taylor County was selected for the GICH program housing, it's a 3 year program. There will be a Workforce Job Fair at Flint on March 18.
